HOLY LAND EXPERIENCES

Walk in the footsteps of Jesus as you visit such ancient sites as Bethlehem, Nazareth and the Sea of Galilee.

Relax for four nights and explore the holy city of Jerusalem.

Follow the Via Dolorosa and walk the path of the Stations of the Cross in the Old City of Jerusalem.

Day 1: Overnight Flight

Celebrate Israel's 60th anniversary as a nation as you journey on an inspirational trip to the Holy Land - where it all began. Walk through city streets that are well over 2,000 years old and visit some of the most ancient sites in the world.

Day 2: Arrive Tel Aviv, Israel

Your tour begins in Tel Aviv. You will meet your tour conductor at the Tel Aviv airport and transfer to our area hotel. This evening, join your fellow travelers for a special welcome dinner. *(D)*

Day 3: Tel Aviv - Jaffa - Caesarea - Haifa - Acre - Tiberias

Begin the day with a drive along the Mediterranean coast to Caesarea by the sea, once capital of the Roman province, and see the Roman and Crusader remains and the harbour from which St. Paul was taken prisoner to Rome. Continue to Mount Carmel at Haifa on our way to the Valley of Armageddon to the excavation site of Tel Megiddo. Then it is to the Jordan River for baptismal service. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Tiberias. *(B, D)*

Day 4: Tiberias

This morning we take our boat ride from Tiberias to Capernaum, there you will see an ancient synagogue and St. Peter's House that was later converted into a church. Also by the shore you will visit Tabgha, site of the Miracle of the Loaves and Fishes. Continue to the Mount of Beatitudes where the Sermon on the Mount is remembered. In the afternoon visit Bethsaida, the place where Jesus healed the blind man and Caesarea Philippi where Peter made his confession "Thou art the Christ". We return to our hotel for dinner and overnight. *(B, D)*

Day 5: Tiberias - Nazareth - Mt Tabor - Jericho, Jerusalem

Start the day with a visit to Nazareth. See the Church of the Annunciation and Mary's Well. Visit Nazareth Village. This is an excavated village dating from around 1AD. The excavations have carefully renovated the synagogue and houses to give a unique insight into village life, as it would have been at the time of Jesus. Continue to Mt. Tabor site of the Transfiguration. Drive on to visit Bet Shean, biblical Scythopolis to Roman Theater. Continue to Jericho to see the excavations of the oldest city in the world. We enjoy a panoramic view of the Promised Land as we ascend Mt. of Temptation where, it is said, Jesus adobe during his 40 days of temptation. We travel through the Judean hills as we drive to Jerusalem. Dinner at our hotel *(B, D)*

Day 6: Mt. of Olives, Gethsemane, Kidron Valley, Mt. Zion and Bethlehem

We drive to Mt of Olives for a panoramic view of Old Jerusalem. See the Place of Ascension and the Patrer Noster Church. As we walk down the Palm Sunday Road passing the Church of the Dormition we visit the Church of All Nations with the ancient olive trees and the Garden of Gethsemane. Our walk down the Kidron Valley takes us to the Pool of Siloam and we will walk through Hezekiah's tunnel. Continue to St. Peter's in Gallicantu built over the palace of the High

Priest Caiphas. On Mt. Zion we visit the Upper room and the Tomb of King David. From here we continue to Bethlehem and see the Church of the Nativity and below it the stable-cave of Jesus birth. Time permitting we drive to the Herodian and visit the excavations of the winter palace of King Herod. Back to Jerusalem for dinner and overnight. *(B, D)*

Day 7: Bethany, Qumran and Dead Sea

Drive to Bethany, home of Mary, Martha and Lazarus. See the wine press and Lazarus' Tomb. Continue to visit Qumran where the Essene enclave was and see the caves where the Dead Sea Scrolls were hidden. Drive along the shore of the Dead Sea to Ein Gedi the place of a cave where, it is said, is where King Saul and David slept, unknowingly, one night. Return to Jerusalem for dinner and overnight. *(B, D)*

Day 8: Jerusalem

We start the day with a visit to the Israel museum and view the Dead Sea Scrolls. From there proceed to the Holocaust Memorial of Yad Vachem. Drive to Ein Karem to visit the birthplace of St. John the Baptist. The afternoon is free to rest or stroll the Old City. Dinner and overnight. *(B, D)*

Day 9: Jerusalem

Today's tour begins as we enter the Old City to visit the Western Wall (Wailing Wall), view the Temple area and the Dome of the Rock where Abraham was going to sacrifice his son. Time to visit the Jewish Quarter and see the Cardo as well as the excavations of the City of David. We leave the Old City and continue to Gordon's Calvary and the Garden Tomb. We will have a communion service here before returning to our hotel for dinner and overnight. *(B, D)*

Day 10: Jerusalem - Tour Ends

We board our motor coach this morning to be transferred to the airport in Tel Aviv and our flight home. Return to Columbus at 8:00pm this evening. *(B)*

Jerusalem's Old City: A Confluence of Faiths

Enter its sacred gates and meander its labyrinth of winding cobblestone streets densely packed in an area covering less than one square mile. In spite of its diminutive size, the walled Old City is of great symbolic importance for Judaism, Christianity and Islam. Your journey with Its Your Trip! includes venerable locations, which have existed for thirty centuries. Walk along the Via Dolorosa or Way of Sorrows to the Church of the Holy Sepulchre, the site of Jesus Christ's crucifixion, burial and resurrection. Observe the solemnity of the Western Wall, the only surviving remnant of Judaism's most sacred shrine, the Temple Mount; and gaze in awe at one of the world's great architectural masterpieces, the Dome of the Rock. To the Muslims it is where the Prophet Muhammad ascended to heaven.
